The Astroni Crater is an inactive volcano located in the Campi Flegrei area at the border of the city of Napoli. It hosts a primary forest showing the inversion of the vegetation components along the crater walls and a couple of ponds at the bottom, and represents an important stop-by spot for migratory birds. Therefore its territory covering about 250 hectares is now destined to a State Natural Reserve managed by the World Wildlife Fund. A suggestive walk at sunset along a path dropping to the bottom of the crater will allow you to enjoy the colours and sounds of this urban forest meeting the night.
